of me John Goddard of Loutham in the County of Nottingham
Student groom I give and bequeath to my Son William Goddard the
Silver Cup that was given to me by the Gentlemen and Farmers of the Hunt
of William Ward Tailby Esquire I give and bequeath to my Son James
Henry Goddard the Silver Horn that was given to me by the Gentlemen and
Farmers of the Shropshire Hunt I give and bequeath to my Son
George Goddard all my hunting Whips I give and bequeath all my
Silver Tea Spoons and Silver Services of which I shall die possessed to my
three daughters Elizabeth Goddard Sarah Ann Goddard and Mary
Mercy Goddard to be divided between them as nearly as may be in equal
shares and if any dispute shall arise concerning the division thereof then
such division shall be made by my Executors hereinafter named whose
determination shall be final I give and bequeath all my money
and securities for money and all the rest residue and remainder of
my personal Estate and Effects not hereinbefore disposed of unto my Son
John Christopher Goddard and my Friend Francis Barnes of Leicester
in the County of Leicester Saddler their executors administrators and assigns
upon trust with all convenient speed after my decease to call in and convert
into money all my said residuary personal Estate or such parts thereof as shall
be of a saleable or convertible nature and out of my said residuary Personal
Estate in the first place to pay ^{and discharge all} my just debts funeral and testamentary
expenses and subject thereto I direct my said Trustees or Trustee for the time
being to stand possessed of my said residuary personal Estate in trust to pay
transfer and divide the same unto and between my said Sons William
Goddard James Henry Goddard and George Goddard and my said
daughters Elizabeth Goddard ~~and~~ Sarah Ann Goddard and Mary
Mercy Goddard and their respective executors administrators and assigns
in equal shares as tenants in common and I expressly declare that
my said Sons William Goddard James Henry Goddard and George Goddard
and my said Daughters shall acquire a vested interest in the said trust monies
immediately upon my decease and I direct that the monies payable under this
my Will to each daughter of mine shall be for her separate use and for
which her receipt alone notwithstanding coverture shall be an effectual discharge
I give and devise all the messuages lands hereditaments and real
estate whatsoever and wheresoever of or to which I am now or at my decease shall

be seized or entitled for any estate or interest whatsoever with the or
appurtenances (except estates vested in me as Trustee or Mortgagee) unto
and to the use of my said Son John Christopher Goddard his heirs and assigns
for ever I give and devise all messuages land and hereditaments vested
in me as Trustee or Mortgagee unto the said John Christopher Goddard
and Francis James their heirs executors administrators and assigns or
according to the tenure thereof respectively subject to such trusts and equities
as may be subsisting therein respectively but the money secured on any such
mortgage to be part of my personal Estate And Lastly I appoint
the said John Christopher Goddard and Francis James
joint Executors of this my Will and guardians of my said Son Georg
Goddard and my said daughter Mary Mercy Goddard during their or
respective minorities In Witness whereof and that I hereby revoke all
former testamentary dispositions I have hereto set my hand the Thirtieth
day of June in the year of our Lord One thousand eight hundred and seventy
Seven.

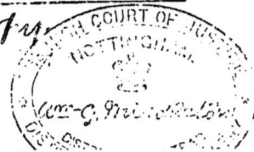

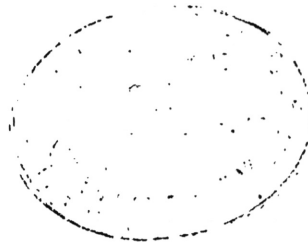
